This park also has exhibits about their part as a Navel Training Center in WWII. Dogs of all sizes are allowed at no additional fee. Dogs may not be left unattended, and they must be quiet, well behaved, leashed and cleaned up after. Dogs are not allowed on the beach or in buildings. Dogs are allowed on the trails. The camping and tent areas also allow dogs. There is a dog walk area at the campground. Dogs are allowed in the camping cabins. Multiple dogs may be allowed.

The camping and tent areas also allow dogs. There is a dog walk area at the campground. Dogs are allowed in the camping cabins. Multiple dogs may be allowed.

Coolin

Steeped in history, this scenic park offers a variety of habitats, trails, and land and water recreation.

Dogs of all sizes are allowed at no additional fee. Dogs may not be left unattended, and they must be quiet, be on no more than a 6 foot leash, and cleaned up after. Dogs are not allowed in the public swim area, but they are allowed at their own designated swim area and on the trails. The camping and tent areas also allow dogs. There is a dog walk area at the campground. Dogs are allowed in the camping cabins. There are no water hookups at the campground. Multiple dogs may be allowed.

Idaho City

This forest has 6 ranger districts, over 2 million acres, and diverse ecosystems that support a large variety of plants, fish, mammals, bird species, and year round recreation. Dogs of all sizes are allowed at no additional fee. Dogs may not be left unattended, and they must be leashed and cleaned up after. Dogs are not allowed on the furniture in the cabins, or in any other park buildings. Dogs are allowed on the trails. This campground is closed during the off-season. The camping and tent areas also allow dogs. There is a dog walk area at the campground. Dogs are allowed in the camping cabins. There are no electric or water hookups at the campground. Multiple dogs may be allowed.

Dogs are allowed in the camping cabins. Multiple dogs may be allowed.
