This winery set out with a goal to produce beautiful unique wines, and now they offer them in their tasting room that is open Saturdays and Sundays from 11am to 5 pm or by appointment. There is outside seating available, and dogs are allowed on the grounds, but not usually in the buildings. Dogs must be friendly, and leashed and cleaned up after at all times.

**TOP 200 PLACE Julian Downtown and Walking Tour** Main Street Julian CA 760-765-1857

You and your pooch can take a self-guided tour of Julian's historical buildings which highlight history from the Gold Rush era to the 1920s. Follow the tour through Main, Second, Third, B, C, and Washington Streets. A map is available at the Julian Chamber of Commerce located on Main and Washington Streets inside the Town Hall. There are also a number of pet-friendly outdoor restaurants and a horse and carriage ride as well as shopping.

**Menghini Winery** 1150 Julian Orchards Drive Julian CA 760-765-2072

This winery produces a variety of premium wines. The tasting room is open daily from 10 am to 4 pm, and they also have a nice picnic area. Dogs are allowed around the grounds, but not in the tasting room. Dogs must be well behaved, and leashed and cleaned up after at all times.

### Parks

**Cuyamaca Ranch State Park** 12551 Highway 79 Descanso CA 760-765-0755

Leashed dogs are allowed on the paved Cuyamaca Peak Fire Road and the Los Caballos/Stonewall Mine Road trails. Bicycles and horseback riders are also allowed on these trails. Dogs are not allowed on any other trails in the park. The Cuyamaca Peak Fire Road is approximately 3.5 miles and goes all the way to the top of the park.
